

## Initiative in War Zone – SI Romania

### 1.Goals of the project.

GOALS
To help the refugees from Ukraine (mainly women and children) and support them in the Romanian borders.
To provide refugees with packages of strict necessity (hygiene and clothing) in Romanian – Ukrainian borders (mainly Isaccea)
To help with access to psychological assistance, help with access to legal assistance, help with access to interpreters and translators, any information and support for women and children.

### 2.Objectives of the project.

OBJECTIVES
The project is targeting 1000 women and children, refugees who are coming in Romania by Isaccea frontier point
To support about 100 women and children in refugees camps in Lunguletu, near Bucharest and other refugees camps.

SPECIFIC	The project is targeting women and children refugees from Ukraine
MEASURABLE	1000 women and children from Isaccea border and 100 women and children from other refugees camps.
ACHIEVABLE	The project involves over 100 soroptimists from across the country (Cluj, Craiova, Bucuresti, Slatina, Targoviste, Timisoara)
RELEVANT	The project helps refugee women and children from Ukraine who have arrived in Romania (over 90,000 people at the moment) who are homeless, have no clothes, need hygienic products.
TIME-BOUND	The project will run for a period of six months, but may be extended as needed

### 3. Need project is addressing:

Today, March 1, marks the sixth day of the Russian-led war in Ukraine, after Vladimir Putin's country launched its first offensive on February 24 against its president, Volodymyr Zelensky, with airstrikes and missiles. Almost 90,000 Ukrainian refugees have entered Romania since the beginning of the war, most of whom are women with children or the elderly, as men have remained at home, according to martial law.

The SI Union wants to help, through this project, women and their children through the packages of strict necessity that it will share.

### 4. Methods of implementing the project:

The project has three main parts:

- A1. Renting an adequate space in Bucharest, which will serve as a center for storing packages and transporting them to Isaccea and other refugee camps.
- A2: Purchasing products of strict necessity and placing them in special backpacks
- A3: Transport of packages and their distribution at the Isaccea border crossing and other refugee camps

## **5. Expected outcomes:**

The project is targeting women and children refugees from Ukraine  
1000 women and children from Isaccea border and 100 women and children from other  
refugees camps.  
The project helps refugee women and children from Ukraine who have arrived in Romania  
(over 90,000 people at the moment) who are homeless, have no clothes, need hygienic  
products.  
The project will run for a period of six months, but may be extended as needed  
The project involves over 100 soroptimists from across the country (Cluj, Craiova, Bucuresti,  
Slatina, Targoviste, Timisoara)

## **6. Partners:**

The project will be implemented by the Soroptimist International Romania Union, the  
communication part of the project will be handled by the Project Manager, who is a TV  
Journalist and who is a communicator specialized on social media.

## **7. Evaluation:**

The project will be monitored by a special commission that is part of the board of the SI  
Union, and which is already constituted, the project team will prepare initial, monthly  
and final reports accompanied by photos and testimonials of beneficiaries that will be  
filmed and posted on the social media of the Union. The local and central press, radio  
and television stations will also be called upon to ensure the visibility of the project.
